The British Council Thailand is hosting the **Alumni Awards 2017**. The Awards recognise and honour the outstanding achievements made by alumni of a UK higher education, and celebrate the impact and value of a UK education. Three prestigious awards categories have been designed to recognise the finalists and winners for their services to the professional and industry namely

- *Professional Achievement*
- *Entrepreneurial Awards*
- *Social Impact Awards.*

If you, or someone you know, studied in the UK and have gone on to achieve exceptional success, get ready to apply or nominate from **7 September 2016**. **Nominations close 16 October**; applications on 31 October 2016.

Who is eligible?

- Alumni must be currently residing in Thailand
- Alumni must have studied in the UK at degree level* or above within the last 15 years (i.e. 2001 or later) for a minimum of one term or semester
- Alumni must enrolled at an officially **recognised** (160 institutions) or **listed** (650 institutions) UK higher education institution

Prepare a statement

If you are **applying yourself**, you will need to answer three short questions on the application form to explain how your UK higher education has contributed to your success and why you think you should be considered for an Alumni Award 2017.

Gathering supporting documents

If you have applied yourself or been nominated, you will need to upload the following documents into your application form:
